

# Illustrator Tools and Palettes #1

This diagram illustrates the various tools and palettes available in Adobe Illustrator. The tools are organized into several groups:

- Main Toolbar:** Includes Line, Arc, Spiral, Rectangular Grid, Polar Grid, Pen Tool, Add Anchor Point Tool, Delete Anchor Point Tool, Convert Anchor Point Tool, Direct Select, Group Select, Direct Select Lasso, and Select Lasso.
- Transform Tools:** Rotate, Reflect, Twist, Warp, Pucker, Scallop, Twirl, Bloat, and Wrinkle.
- Shape Tools:** Rectangle, Round Rectangle, Oval, Polygon, Star, Flare, and Erase.
- Text Tools:** Text, Text Area, Text Path (R), Text Path (L), Vertical Text, and Vertical Text Area.
- Painting Tools:** Paint Brush, Pencil, and Smooth.
- Editing Tools:** Rotate, Scale, Free Transform, Shear, Scissors, and Knife Tool.
- Selection Tools:** Select, Direct Select, Direct Select Lasso, and Hand.
- Symbol Tools:** Symbol Sprayer, Symbol Spinner, Symbol Styler, Symbol Shifter, Symbol Sizer, Symbol Screener, Symbol Scruncher, and Symbol Stainer.
- Color and Fill Tools:** Eyedropper, Measure, Paint Bucket, Swap Fill/Stroke, Toggle Stroke, Toggle Fill, Default Fill/Stroke, Color, Gradient, and Full Screen Mode.
- Graphing Tools:** Column Graph, Bar Graph, Stacked Column Graph, Stacked Bar Graph, Area Graph, Pie Graph, Scatter Graph, Line Graph, Radar Graph, and Pie Graph.
- Other Tools:** Slice, Slice Selection, Printable Page, and Blend.

The palettes shown include the Swatches Palette and the Stroke Palette.
